

Several orders of the Governor of Utah are illegal.

Do you know why?

According to the Utah State Constitution and State Code:

The Governor cannot MAKE laws.
Utah Constitution Article VI, Section 1

But, the Governor has emergency powers, right? Perhaps, but...

The Governor, under Emergency, can only SUSPEND existing laws.
Utah Code 53-2a-209

But, there is a phrase saying "make orders, rules etc." in the code. Can an order still be made into law? Perhaps, but...

The Governor, cannot name a CLASS of people, businesses, or organizations in his "orders".
Utah Code 63G-3-102

What does this mean?

It means all orders of the Governor of Utah, which apply to a "class" of organizations or people, such as: *Elderly, children, "all individuals", churches, schools, businesses, "essential" or "non-essential businesses", or nonprofits...*

ARE ILLEGAL

It also means that all of the "plans" such as "Utah Leads Together" and "Phased Health guidelines" (Color Codes) are illegal, by definition, when used in the Governor's order.

You do not need to follow any of them. Call out the bluff instead.
